

Illinois Comprehensive Health Insurance Plan I-CHIP

I-CHIP is a state of Illinois health benefits program and following information is a general overview and is not intended to be official representation. For complete details about the program use the Web address shown below or contact **I-CHIP** by calling the number shown.

I-CHIP is not an insurance company or entitlement program. **I-CHIP** is funded partly by premiums paid by its participants and may receive an appropriation from the State's General Revenue Fund.

Premiums charged are established by law at from 125%-150% of the average rates charged individuals for comparable major medical coverage by five or more of the largest insurance companies in the individual health insurance market in Illinois.

Illinois residents may qualify for **I-CHIP** if they meet one of the following criteria:

- If they have applied for individual health insurance and have been rejected because of a pre-existing condition;
- If they have an individual policy that is substantially similar to CHIP which costs them more than they would pay for CHIP coverage; or
- If they have one of 31 presumptive medical conditions i.e., conditions presumed to result in automatic rejection by an insurance company.
